

Resolute Bay 1878

Receipt of air

Wednesday Jan 29th

18-B- This day begins calm and hazy
Latter strong breeze from N

Thursday Jan 30th

56-B- This day comes - calm the air
thick with frost. Middle part
strong breeze from N. Latter part
calm and clear - the natives arrived
from Capt P. for more provisions
Reports saying plenty of deer

Friday Jan 31st

56-B- This day we have had light air
from N with clear and cold
weather. - Five natives with a
dog team started for Capt Patten
Camp with provisions

Saturday Jan Feb 1st

54-B- This day begins with a light breeze
from N and clear. Latter part
calm and pleasant

Sunday Feb 2nd

52-B- This day has been calm -
clear and pleasant - The natives
are unsuccessful sealing and
are suffering much from hunger

Winter Quarters 1878

Receipt of air

Monday Feb 3rd

16-B- This day we have had a light air
from N with fine clear weather.
The natives arrived tonight with the
dog team from the Capt for provisions

Tuesday Feb 4th

4-B- This day we have had a light breeze
from N with clear fine weather.
At noon the men the dog team started
with provisions for Capt Patten Camp

Wednesday Feb 5th

36-B- This day we have a strong gale
from N with thick weather and
a light fall of snow. Latter part
more moderate

Thursday Feb 6th

20-B- This day we have had a light air
from N with fine clear weather.
The dog team arrived from the Capt
camp. Reports from coming in this day

Friday Feb 7th

14-B- This day we have had a strong
wind from N E with thick
cloudy weather. There is a
load of ice
