Empty of air.

Thursday March 13th

- 6-B. This day commences with a strong gale from S.E. the air thick with drifting snow. Latter part gale moderated from

Friday March 14th

- 20-B. This day begins with a strong gale from N.W. and clear weather. Latter part moderate and pleasant

Saturday March 15th

- 44-B. Comes with light air from W. Latter part light breeze from S.W. and pleasant

Sunday March 16th

- 14-B. This day we have had a strong wind from S.W. with clear weather

Monday March 17th

- 46-B. This day we have had a strong gale from N.W. with clear weather

Tuesday March 18th

- 44-B. First part we had a fresh breeze from W. with pleasant weather. Latter part calm and pleasant. Several breaths. Diaries arrived and brought from seal skins

Winter Quarters Mid. land 1873

- 12-B. This day begins with light breeze from E. and pleasant weather.

11. Middle part light air from S.E. Latter part light air from S.W. and fine weather.

Thursday March 20th

- 22-B. This day we have had light breeze from S.E. with hazy weather.

Wednesday March 21st

- 10-B. This day light air from S.E. with thick hazy and light fall of snow. The natives caught a Walrus today. Mr. Miller returned to the ship with three dogs and eight seal skins he traded for

Saturday March 22nd

- 22-B. This day we have had a moderate breeze from N.E. with thick cloudy weather.

Sunday March 23rd

- 13-B. Light and variable air from S and E with fine weather

Monday March 24th

- 10-B. This day has been calm and fine weather.
