Tuesday March 25th

20-B- This day has been calm and
fine weather

Wednesday March 26th

20-B- This day we have had a strong gale
from N N W. The air thick with
drifting snow

Thursday March 27th

30-B- First some moderate parts strong wind
from N N W with clear weather
Latter part more moderate

Friday March 28th

32-B- Stormy wind from N with clear
weather Latter part calm and
pleasant

Saturday March 29th

33-B- This day we have had a light breeze
from N W with fine weather

Sunday March 30th

4-B- First part light breeze from
S E with thick weather and
light fall of snow Latter part
wind S W and thick weather

Winter Quarters 1893

Sunday March 31st

Height of air
2-B- This day has been calm and fine
weather - Capt Potter started for
Wager River this morning with a dog
team and four natives - at 3 P M
the team returned for a tent and
some bread

Tuesday March 31st

10-B- This day has been calm and pleasant
Latter part light air from N
Some of the natives returned with
part of a walrus

Wednesday April 1st

22-B- This day we have had light air
from N W with fine weather
Some natives arrived today reported
Capt-Potter left Beachy Point yesterday

Thursday April 2nd

14-B- This day has been fine and pleasant
with light variable air from
N & W

Friday April 3rd

22-B- First part calm and pleasant
Latter part light breeze
from S E and pleasant
Cooper and Bodstener went Deer
hunting but saw none
