

Repulse Bay 1843

Sumpt. of air later day Apr 5th

14-B- This day begins with a light S E wind and hazy weather

10-A- Latter part light air from N.W. with clear weather

Sunday Apr 6th

4-B This day begins with light variable air and hazy weather. Middle

24-A and latter parts light air from S and S E. Three natives went Deer hunting today

Monday Apr 7th

2-A These 24 hours we have had a strong gale from S E with snow

Tuesday Apr 8th

10-A The gale continues strong from S E with light snow

Wednesday Apr 9th

4-A- First wind strong from E and cloudy Latter part strong gale from N E with snow

Thursday Apr 10th

11-A- This day begins with a strong gale from N E with snow Middle and latter moderate wind from E and cleared up a little

Winter Quarters 1843

Friday Apr 11th

1-A This day begins with a snow storm and strong gale at E N E - Latter part moderated a little but continues snowing

Saturday Apr 12th

23-A- This day wind has been strong from E with snow. The snow is getting deep which will make it bad traveling for Capt. Potter

Sunday Apr 13th

14-A- This day begins with a fresh breeze from E with snow - Latter part wind shifted to W and cleared up

Monday Apr 14th

6-A- This day has been calm and pleasant. Unhoused the Quarters deck and hove out a cask of Beef and one of Pork - hauled a load of ice. 2. Willies off duty sick. Put the Galley stove on deck

Tuesday Apr 15th

4-B This day we have had a moderate wind from W and cloudy. One native returned from Deer hunting and brought a saddle of meat. They had killed 5 or 6
