 Latter part wind N E and cloudy

Thursday Apr 17th
 4-B This day has been pleasant
 with a fresh breeze from N W
 Employed digging some corks out
 of the snow and clearing the snow
 of deck
 9-A-

Friday Apr 18th
 2-B This the wind has been fresh from
 4-A- N W with clear weather

Saturday Apr 19th
 4-B- This day begins with a heavy gale
 and snow storm from N E
 Middle part The gale continues
 at S E Latter part from E
 15-A- and snowing falling fast

Sunday Apr 20th
 Comes with fresh wind
 from N W with clear weather
 22-A Middle and Latter parts
 calm and pleasant

Monday Apr 21st
 10-A- This day begins with light air from
 N and fine weather Middle and
 Latter parts much the same
 The snow thawed on deck to day for
 the first time this spring - Employed
 10-A- clearing the snow off deck and
 making a sled - Blacksmith work at
 the Forge

Tuesday Apr 22nd
 5-B This day we have a light breeze
 from N W and fine weather Employed
 making a sled and sizing stuff
 and latter job. Several natives
 arrived from Deer hunting They have
 20-A- got 2 Deer They brought aboard the
 Quarters of 4 Deer Mr Willis returned
 been gone 6 days, did get my Deer

Wednesday Apr 23rd
 1-B This we have had a light breeze
 from N W with fine weather
 15-A- Hauled some ice and other jobs

Thursday Apr 24th
 2-A First part light air from N
 and fine weather Middle and
 Latter parts fresh breeze from N
 20-A- to N W Brought off three
 boats from the Shore
