

Repulse Bay 1873

Friday Apr 25th

- 2-A This day begins with a strong breeze from N.W. and clear weather. Mid- and latter parts moderate breeze from the same quarter and fine weather. Employed hauling ice from the shore and getting out Bone for sleds.

Saturday Apr 26th

- 15-A Comes with a light breeze from N.W. and cloudy. Latter part strong breeze from W. - Employed hauling ice and shoeing a sled.

Sunday Apr 27th

- 6-A This day we have had light air from W. with cloudy weather and a little snow. Two arrived from Deer hunting brought on board two saddle of meat.

Monday Apr 28th

- 7-A Comes with light air from S. and cloudy. Middle part calm with light snow. Latter part light air from N. - Bent the plank cleaning out provisions cart - making Broomes and after jibs - Capt. Pett returned to night from W. River been gone 24 days - Brought several musk ox and seal skins.

Winter Quarters 1873

Tuesday Apr 29th

- 10-A This day we have had a fresh breeze from N. with cloudy weather and light spots of snow.

Wednesday Apr 30th

- 10-A Comes with light breeze from N.W. and hazy weather. Employed breaking out the after hold - P.M. Blowing strong. Latter part, moderate breeze and clear weather.

Thursday May 1st

- 0- This day begins with a fresh breeze from N.W. with clear weather. Mid- and latter parts blowing a fresh gale from the same quarter. A.M. hauled some carter from shore.

Friday May 2nd

- 11-A This day begins calm and fine weather. Latter part breeze from W. all hands employed showing ground. After hold up filling with salt water, out out the rectifier.

Saturday May 3rd

- This begins calm and cloudy. Middle part calm and pleasant. Latter part light breeze from W. and cloudy. Employed showing after hold and filling ground forward with salt water.
