

Repulse Bay 1873

Sunday May 4th

- 18-A This day begins with a strong wind and snow from N.E. First part the same. Latter part fresh breeze from N. with clear weather and growing cold.

Monday May 5th

- 6-B This day begins calm and pleasant. Latter part fresh gale from S.E. with snow. Finished filling the ground forward with salt water and stowed the fore hold.

Tuesday May 6th

- 41-A This day begins with a light breeze from S.E. and cloudy. Latter part fresh breeze from N.W. with clear weather. Employed Coopering black-smithing and various other jobs.

Wednesday May 7th

This day begins with a fresh breeze from N.E. and cloudy. Latter part strong gale from N.E. with a severe snow storm. Employed making tents.

Thursday May 8th

- 9-A This day begins with a strong gale and snow storm from N.E. Much ice moving strong from N.W. Latter part moderate wind from same point and pleasant.

Winter Quarters 1873

Friday May 9th

- 7-B This day begins with a strong gale from S.W. and snow. Latter part clear. Latter part moderate wind from S.W. with pleasant weather. The natives started musk ox hunting.

Saturday May 10th

- 20-A This day begins with a light southerly wind and snow. Latter part light and variable winds and fine weather. Employed making tents.

Sunday May 11th

- 20-A This day we have had a strong gale from N.E. First part. Latter part cloudy.

Monday May 12th

- 20-A This day comes with a strong gale and snow storm from N.E. Latter part more moderate from S.E. with snow.

Tuesday May 13th

- 20-A This day begins with a fresh breeze from S.E. with cloudy weather. Latter part wind N.E. with a snow storm.

Wednesday May 14th

- 20-A This day we have had light breeze from S.E. with thick hazy weather.
