

Resolute Bay. 1873

Monday May 26th

36 A. This begins with a light breeze from S.W. and pleasant weather. Latter part wind N.E. and cloudy.

Employer waiting Bone. (B from Mr. Miller and natives went with provisions to

Tuesday May 27th

Strong wind from N.W. with passing clouds. Mr. Miller and the team return tonight. Drying Bone.

Wednesday May 28th

36 A. This day begins with a fresh breeze from N. and clear weather. Latter part light breeze from N. and cloudy. Bunch about 1700 lbs of Bone that we got from the natives.

Thursday May 29th

This day begins with a strong wind from N. with passing clouds. Middle and latter parts some N.W. & strong with darker clouds. Most of the natives arrived from Deer hunting.

Friday May 30th

This day begins a light breeze from S.W. and cloudy. Middle part strong breeze from N.W. with passing clouds. Latter part wind N.E. with snow squalls. Getting ready to start down the valley with boats.

Winter Quarter May 31st 1873

This begins and ends with a heavy gale from N. with passing and snow squalls.

Sunday June 1st

This day begins with a strong wind from N. Middle part moderate. Latter part strong gale from S.W. with snow squalls.

Monday June 2nd

Comes with light air from W. with rain. Clouds to N. and clear up. At 6 A.M. the three boats started for B. Sound. Latter part weather much the same.

Tuesday June 3rd

Comes with light breeze from N. and fine weather through the day.

Wednesday June 4th

Light air from S. with fine weather. Made a dog sled.

Thursday June 5th

Fresh breeze from S.W. and fine weather through the day.

Friday June 6th

Light breeze from N. and pleasant through the day. Got a cask of water.
