

Sunday July 6th
Fresh breeze from N.W. Sent 2 sleds
on search of Muller. found him
about 15 mls off towards Beachy Point
Latter part wind S.

Monday July 7th
Strong wind from N.E. Latter part
strong gale with rain. Painted Cabin

Tuesday July 8th
Light breeze from S. and cloudy
Got the blubber of 25 Seals

Wednesday July 9th
Light breeze from S. with frequent
rain squalls

Thursday July 10th
Light breeze from W. - with fine
weather

Friday July 11th
Light var. winds and fine weather
got a little more blubber and a large Seal
skin

Saturday July 12th
Comes - with a fresh breeze N.E.
with fog. Mud and Latter part rain

Sunday July 13th
Comes with light wind from S. and
thick cloudy weather. Mud part rain
squalls. Latter part light air from N.

Monday July 14th
Comes with fresh breeze from S. with
fine weather. The Boat, crew, returned
from the Whale Point expedition with one
boat on a sled, left two boats at B Point
in charge of two men

Abstract from the Journal of the Expedition
The Boats left B Point June 3rd at 10 A.M.
heavily loaded with (7 bbls and 6 Boxes Bread 1200
3 lbs Meat 1600 Indolene which 3 men lost outside
baggage and cutting gear) and proceeded
down the river with a strong northerly wind.
Arrived at Wager River on 4th June with a
fresh S.E. wind found much scattering ice
in mouth of the river, and while looking for
a place to land the current ran so swift
as to take us up the River where we camped
June 6th struck camp and started on our journey
with a light breeze from W. to P.M. wind turned
to S. and late being ahead hauled up the boat and
camped 12 mls S. of Wager River.
June 8th 10 A.M. struck camp and started
with a fresh heavy breeze from N.E. As we
went we found the floor made off shore from
3 to 15 mls. and much ice outside of us
which proved to be a heavy pack. At 4 P.M.
having made 25 or 30 mls we found the pack joined
on the floor and stopped further progress to land.
At the same time the pack commenced closing
on the floor. Rapidly unloaded our boats and
loaded them on very rough floor moved back
2 mls. camped for the night. June 9th Strong
westerly wind no water in sight. Found
