Tuesday the 8 fine moder wind n e course in all sail
set hands in polyeed reapiely at Board at noon we
land a head distant 25 miles the island of Fere gam
at 6 am took in the top gallant sail and course
and reefed the top sails and halled off from the land
heading s e land distant 12 miles bearing n m by m

Wednesday the 9 fine moder wind n e 2 sails in
sight running in for the land spoke several flocks at
noon hove to off the harbor at Fere gam 4 ships
the Capt West on shore at 5 a m came on board with
board 4 ships stood off shore heading s e under
2 top sails and fore sail night fine wind n e

Thursday the 10 fresh gales wind e standing on and
off the Bay of Fere gam 5 ships the Capt on shore
see hands backs looped 2 boats the mast boat
darted and missed ships in the Bay the globe
noted the routes the end day the flocks still
at 3 a m the Capt on shore and boatmen
at 5 am the boat came off the Capt on shore at 4 am
sent a boat on shore for the Capt at 8 a m the
Capt came on board off shore heading s e wind
e 4 ships run off the shore the wind s s w

Friday the 11 fine moder wind n e made all sail and
stand in Fere gam Bay sent a boat on shore
for the gunner see hands backs looped 2 boats got
near the gunner came on board at 10 p m we
made all sail for the island of saypan see a sail
at 6 a m and reefed the top sail and stood off
the harbor of saypan night fine wind light

Saturday the 12 fine moder wind n e 2 boats on shore
ship laying on and off at 4 a m the boats came
on board made sail stood off and on shore
the Bay of saypan 2 sails in sight laying
night fine wind light from the n e

Sunday the 13 fresh gales wind n e 2 sails in sight laying
on and off the harbor of saypan the Capt and 2 meat
men on shore at noon at 5 a m came on board with
boat load yeams and white taters pigs and flocks at
6 a m made sail for the Fere gam Bay steering n m by n

Monday the 14 fine moder wind n e course in all sail
set hands in polyeed reapiely on board put up the back
of lines and milled licks out at the mast heads at
6 a m set the flying jib and sta sail night fine
lat 16° 4' n long 146° 14' e

Tuesday the 15 fine moder wind n e course in all
sail set hands in polyeed reapiely on board the flocks
at 6 a m took in the top gallant sail night fine
lat 14° 54' n long 142° 14' e

Wednesday the 16 fresh gales wind n e course in all sail
took in the top gallant sail and flying jib at 6 a m
took 2 reefs in the top sail blowing fresh kept the
boats on the upon crans night wind and clouds

Thursday the 17 fine moder wind n e course in all
hands in polyeed reapiely on board all sail set licks
out for whole set five backs and black fish
at noon in lat 20° 14' n long 139° 18' e night fine land

Friday the 18 fine moder wind n e course in all sail
set hands in polyeed reapiely on board licks out for
whole at noon in lat 21° 34' n long 138° 24' e night fine

Saturday the 19 in the forenoon fine wind n e heading n m
all sail set hands in polyeed reapiely on board at 3 a m
fresh gales wind n e heading n m took in the top
gallant sail and flying jib duffed reefed the
top sail and took in the main sail shaped
the deck at noon in lat 22° 46' n long 136° 38' e
blowing fresh wind n e heading n m
