Monday the 22 fine wester wind light all sail set standing  
a long shore one sail in sight see six seals and  
five boats at noon in lat 5910 n close in shore

Tuesday the 23 fine wester wind light n n e all sail set  
standing a long shore spoke the the article of whale 12 ships  
in sight seen six seals at noon wind light water smooth

Friday the 24 fine wester wind light all sail set standing  
a long shore 4 sail in sight the low but most in shore  
at 4 a m seen blackhead whale loosed 2 boats whale gone fast  
in shore at 4 a m the capt took sick night fine wind

Saturday the 25 fine wester wind light s w all sail set standing  
long shore one went in shore 2 sail in sight one at anchor  
at noon in lat 5920 n at 4 a m clouds and hard wind light  
at 4 a m all sail set heading see ten seals and five boats

Sunday the 26 fine wester wind s w light all sail set land  
on the last but some heading e one sail in sight hands un-  
folded breaking out water night large heading all sail set

Monday the 27 fresh gale wind e s e close in shore see  
whale loosed 2 boats wind blowing fresh in sail here to  
heading off shore blowing hard large sea running high

Tuesday the 28 storm wester and fog and rain at 4 p m  
upon ship heading n e in shore at noon upon ship  
heading s e blowing hard fog and rain sea running high

Wednesday the 29 fresh gale and fog standing shore  
see land at 11 p m in 10 fathoms at water man strike  
heading e s e fog and rain blowing hard all day

Thursday the 30 large and rain wester wind n n e  
heading a wester dulled reef top sail one sail in  
sight standing s e fog and rain wester at noon  
in lat 5840 n took the four sail and main sail  
at 4 a m set the four sail and set and  
main night fog and rain blowing fresh

JULY

Friday the 1 fine wester wind n n e all sail set heading s w  
1 sail in sight at 11 p m sun off s w at noon in lat 5920 n  
at 4 a m storm wester wind light n n e all sail set

Saturday the 2 fine wester wind n n e all sail set heading s w  
for some island see no ships nor whale at noon lat 5840 n  
at 4 a m a fine fresh water ground at 4 a m clouds and  
hard yards were running for four the wind all sail set

Sunday the 3 fine wester wind n n e all sail set heading s w  
see hump backs and five seals 2 sail in sight one trying  
out loosed one boat after five seals night fine and soon

Monday the 4 fine wester wind s e light and fog at  
8 p m close spoke the seven 3 whales the capt went  
on got one cast of down gave 162 gallons all sail set  
see a large hump back the largest seen i have seen  
at 2 a m heading s w all sail set wind light s e

Tuesday the 5 fine wester wind s e all sail set heading in  
shore see land a head of sail in shore trying out see  
fishers shanters in the lee bow bearing W 2 ships stand-  
ing off shore 4 standing in shore wind light

Wednesday the 6 fine wester wind s all sail set heading  
W 10 sail in sight one trying out spoke the index of red  
land on the capt went on board got one cast of broad  
gave 81 gallons spoke a sea hare back 8 whales at noon  
main close to sea at 4 a m made Shorton island light  
and rain wind seen no whales ship all second night fog

Thursday the 7 fine wester wind n n e all sail set heading in  
the sea 20 sail in sight one trying out seen whale gone in for  
the day loosed 2 boats whale gone fast night fine standing  
in for the land 20 sail in sight standing in southern land

Friday the 8 fine W all sail set battling three times  
21 sail in sight one trying out seen a dead  
whale took it a long side at 4 a m cloud down  
the sails down mast setting at 8 a m at 2 p m  
down setting in closed decks 2 sail in sight  
one trying set the wash iron ship for  
sea land and day all second
