Monday the 3 fine weather Wind W all sail set heading

 the crew in port and brooding out from clarks got 6 casks
 of Water on clarks 2 casks of Whale liver on board of oil
 at 4 a m blowing hard took in the flying and four top
 gallant sail decked reefed the top sail took in main sail
 and main top gallant sail night Wind and little

Wednesday the 5 fresh Gale Wind S E breeze S by E running
 under decked reef top sail jib and main sail at
 3 a m took in the main and jib close reefed the main
 top sail took in the four top sail blowing hard and
 rain says running high at 6 set the four top sail and
 main top sail took in the four top sail blowing
 from the S E heading S by E says running high
 little and rain blowing at 4 a m
