Saturday July 20th 1854

First part of these 24 hours light winds
from the N. clear weather morning
Dinner weather N. 11 O. m. rainy
latter part light winds from the N.
with rain some birds these 24 hours

Sunday July 21st 1854 First part of these
24 hours light winds from the N. with
foggy latter part clear weather
I should think that the officers have been
in charge as others have shifted to the Barge
but I have not been informed of it by the
Capt. So ends these 24 hours

Monday July 22nd 1854 fitting Rigging took on board
one raft water first part of these 24 hours clear the wind
N. W. middle latter the wind do latter
cloudy with rain so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday July 23rd 1854 first part of these 24 hours
cloudy with rain the wind light from the N. & W. rd
middle cloudy weather with rain the wind light do
latter cloudy with some rain the wind light
S. & S. W. rd. these 24 hours thus fitting Rigging Cleaning
ship &

Wednesday July 24th 1854 the first part of these
mild pleasant weather light air from the S. rd & W. rd
middle part squally and raining the wind to the N. rd
latter part mild and pleasant light air from the S. rd
employed bending sails so ends these 24 hours

Thursday July 25th 1854 the first part mild
pleasant weather the wind to the S. rd & W. rd
middle as fine pleasant weather light breeze from
the S. rd & W. rd latter pleasant the same the same
employed fitting rigging & recruiting ship
so ends these 24 hours

Talcahuano Barge Globe Friday July 21st 1854
the first part of these 24 hours mild pleasant weather
light winds from the S. rd & W. rd middle and latter
part fair & pleasant weather the wind the same
employed fitting ship for sea took on board one
boat load of wood and four casks of water so ends
these 24 hours

Saturday July 22nd 1854
the first part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
the wind S. rd & W. rd middle & latter mild pleasant
weather the wind light from the S. rd and W. rd
employed fitting rigging & so ends these 24 hours

Sunday July 23rd 1854 the first part of these
24 hours fine pleasant weather light breeze from the
S. rd and W. rd middle do latter cloudy weather
strong breeze from the N. rd and W. rd so ends
these 24 hours

Monday July 24th 1854 the first part of these
24 hours cloudy with a strong breeze from the N. rd
middle cloudy the wind light from the N. rd
latter calms & light from the S. rd and cloudy
employed in ship's duty so ends these 24 hours
corkers came on board

Tuesday July 25th 1854 first part of these 24 hours
clear weather the wind from the S. rd middle pleasant
the same latter light wind from the S. rd & W. rd pleasant
weather employed in ship's duty fitting rigging
& so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday July 26th 1854 first part pleasant weather the
wind from the S. rd middle the same latter cloudy and
the same wind from the S. rd strong took on board
3 boat loads of wood & so ends these 24 hours

Thursday July 27th 1854 the first part of the 24 hours
clear weather the wind light from the southward
middle part pleasant weather the wind the same
latter light air & calms from the S. rd employed in ship
duty we took on board 3 boat loads of wood & so ends these 24 hours
