Sunday Oct. 3rd Commences with light baffling winds & squally steering to the South. saw plenty Blackfish at 4 P.M. saw two sperm whales lowered the Boats got none at dark. Came on Board. lay aback till 6 P.M. then braced full by the wind to the N. E. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze from the S. E. at 7 A.M. saw sperm whales lowered the Boats did not get any at dawn. Came on Board. whales still in sight

Monday Oct. 4th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S. E. with smoky weather. at 5 P.M. saw whales lowered the Boats got four. at 10 P.M. got the last one to the ship. heading East. Middle & latter parts fine weather & light winds. at daylight got ready & commenced cutting saw two sail

Tuesday Oct. 5th Commences with light breeze from S. E. & pleasant. at 12 1/2 P.M. finished cutting & wore ship to the S. W. employed clearing away the heads. Middle part at 10 P.M. commenced Boiling. latter part light variable winds with passing squalls. heading to the westward. saw a sail
