 Sunday Oct 31st Commences with squally
 rainy weather. wind variable from S.E. to S.W.
 heading to the Eastward at 7 P.M. wore ship to the
 W.S.W. Middle & latter parts strong wind from S.E. with
 rain. heading to the S.W. one man sick.

 Long. Obs 35. 26 W

Monday November 1st Commences with a strong wind
 from the S.E. with squally rainy weather heading
 to the S.W. at sunset took in the foretop sail. Middle
 & latter parts wind & weather the same. one man sick.

 Long. Obs 35. 26 W

Tuesday Nov 2nd Commences with strong breeze from the
 S.E. with squally weather heading to the South. Middle
 part more moderate. latter part moderate breeze from
 the North with hazy weather steering to the South. at 8 A.M.
 saw two sperm whales heading to the South. at 8¹/₂ toward
 the Boats & got one. at Noon took him alongside

Wednesday Nov 3rd Commences with a moderate breeze
 from the North. got ready & commenced cutting. at dark
 had the head mast off & jaw in. Middle & latter parts
 pleasant weather. at 6 A.M. called all hands & commenced
 cutting. at Noon the Body in. saw five sail

Thursday Nov 4th Commences with a light breeze from
 the S.W. employed Bailing the Case. at 4 P.M. finished
 & commenced Boiling. wore ship to the S.E. Middle
 & latter parts pleasant weather heading to the westward
 employed Boiling

Friday Nov 5th Commences with a light breeze from
 the S.W. heading to the westward. Middle & latter parts
 cloudy. employed Boiling.

Saturday Nov 6th Commences with a moderate breeze from
 the S.W. with cloudy weather heading to the westward
 at 3 P.M. came up squally with rain took in foretop sail
 & jib. at 10 P.M. finished Boiling. Middle & latter parts light
 breeze from the S.E. heading S.W. saw a fin back

Sunday Nov 7th Commences with light airs from the S.E.
 with cloudy weather. heading S.W. at sunset shortened sail
 Middle & latter parts the same saw two Bigs

Monday Nov 8th Commences with a light breeze from the
 S.E. & cloudy weather with passing squalls. heading
 N.W. & N. Boarded a spanish Brig from Madara River
 to Montevideo. Middle & latter parts a fresh breeze from
 the N.E. with thick weather. employed stowing down oil
 saw a ship

Tuesday Nov 9th Commences with a fresh breeze from the
 N.E. with cloudy weather heading to the N.E. at 5 P.M.
 finished stowing down. Middle & latter parts variable wind
 with rain heading from N to South. employed stowing
 away empty cask

 Long. Obs 36. 04 W

Wednesday Nov 10th Commences with a fresh breeze from
 S.W. with cloudy weather heading to the South. at
 sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts fresh breeze
 heading to the W.S.W. all sail on. employed at ship's duty
