Thursday Nov 11th Commences with a moderate breeze from the South with cloudy weather. heading to the N.W. at sunset shortened sail & wore ship to the S.E. middle part wind hauled to the S.W. wore ship to the South. latter part moderate breeze & pleasant sun. three sail employed at ships duty

Friday Nov 12th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. with pleasant weather. heading to the South. saw finbacks at sunset shortened sail. middle & latter parts fresh breeze the Eastward. took down the main topsail & cut off a piece. at 11 A.M. bent it again

Saturday Nov 13th Commences with a fresh breeze from the Eastward & cloudy steering to the South. at 11 P.M. saw a school of sperm whales. lowered the boats at sunset struck three got two lost one the ^{line} was bit off by a whale. at 11 P.M. took the whales to the ship & shortened sail. middle part strong breeze. latter part moderate breeze from the S.W. at daylight got ready & commenced setting at 11 A.M. finished. saw a school of sperm whales going to the West

Sunday Nov 14th Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. & rugged. at 12 P.M. lowered the boats for whales at dark come on board without a whale. shortened sail heading to the North. employed clearing away the heads & jabs. middle part strong breeze took in jib & bonnet sail latter part fresh breeze employed Boiling saw Breaches

Monday Nov 15th Commences with a fresh breeze from the East with pleasant weather heading to the S.E. at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. & middle & latter parts moderate breeze from E to N.E. at 12 A.M. tacked to the S.E. at 4 A.M. finished Boiling. at 7 made all sail

Tuesday Nov 16th Commences with a moderate breeze from the N.E. with pleasant weather. heading to the S.E. at 4 P.M. tacked to the N.W. at sunset shortened sail. middle & latter parts strong wind with smoky weather employed at ships duty

Wednesday Nov 17th Commences with a strong breeze from the N.E. with hazy weather. heading to the S.E. at 8 P.M. tacked to the N.W. at sunset shortened sail. middle part the same. latter part commenced breaking out to stow oil at 11 A.M. the wind hauled to the south & commenced to rain. took in the fore topsail

Thursday Nov 18th Commences with a fresh breeze from the South with rain. at 4 P.M. finished stowing down oil. middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. heading to the S.W.

Friday Nov 19th Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.E. with thick weather & fine rain. heading to the S.W. saw a ship & a Brig. at sunset shortened sail middle & latter parts strong breeze & rugged. at daylight made sail. saw a Bremen Brig steering to the N.E. at noon wore ship to the North
