Wednesday Feb 2nd Commences with a moderate breeze from the South with hazy weather. steering E.S.E. spoke the Barks Connelia of N.B. 720 sp. & Reoka of Westport 200 sp. & 300 hump back at 11 P.M. wore ship to the E.S.E. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same heading to the E.S.E. the Connelia & Reoka in company. got a cask of water from the Connelia

Thursday Feb 3rd Commences with a moderate breeze from the South with hazy weather. heading to the E.S.E. at sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. at 6 A.M. tacked to the Westward. spoke the Reoka & got two cask of water from her. saw Blackfish
