

Remarks on Board Bark Globe. 1859.

Thursday March 3rd these 24 hours pleasant weather at 8 A.M. the Starboard watch went ashore on liberty. at Dark all came on board except Joseph a Portuguese. employed taking on board recruits & painting ship. Main in Irons

Friday March 4th these 24 hours fresh breeze. at 7 A.M. the Starboard watch went on liberty. at Dark the watch came on board except French & Resbury Jones the Portuguese came on board. employed at ships duty. Main in Irons

Saturday March 5th these 24 hours pleasant weather at daylight French & Jones came on board. employed stowing away water.

Sunday March 6th these 24 hours pleasant weather

Monday March 7th Commences with light breeze & pleasant. employed getting ready for sea. Middle and latter parts. Moderate breeze from the S.E. at 7 A.M. the Pilot came on board we took our anchor & stood out to sea. heading West & S. employed stowing the anchors & chains. Charles Carroll agreed to go the voyage with us for the 180th day.

Tuesday March 8th Commences with light airs from the S.E. with pleasant weather heading W & W.S. took Main out of Irons. Middle & latter parts the same

Wednesday March 9th Commences with light breeze from S.E. & S. with pleasant weather heading W & N. at sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. at daylight took in the starboard Boat to repair

Thursday March 10th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. & S. with pleasant weather heading W & N. saw fin backs. at sunset shortened sail. Middle and latter parts light airs & pleasant heading W & N. employed repairing the starboard Boat.

Friday March 11th Commences with light airs from the N.W. to S.W. with pleasant weather heading W & N. to N.W. at 4 P.M. put the starboard Boat out. Middle and latter parts wind & weather the same. employed painting the Boats in side saw fin backs & frampises

Saturday March 12th Commences with light airs from the S.W. with pleasant weather heading W & N. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. employed at ships duty. one man sick

Sunday March 13th Commences with a moderate breeze from the N.W. with pleasant weather heading W & N. at sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. saw porpoises

Monday March 14th Commences with light wind from the South with pleasant weather at 1 P.M. tacked to the S.E. at sunset took in the light sail. Middle part at 11 P.M. tacked to the S.W. & W. latter part hazy

Tuesday March 15th Commences with moderate wind from the S.E. & S. with hazy weather heading to the S.W. & W. at sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze. at 11 A.M. saw a spout 3 miles off
