Friday May 6th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. with hazy weather heading to the S.E. & middle & latter parts the same

Sunday May 8th Commences with with a moderate breeze from the S.W. with pleasant weather steering N.E. at sunset took in the light sail & hauled up the fore-sail. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same at 7 A.M. made all sail steering N.E. & S.

Monday May 9th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. with pleasant weather steering N.E. at sunset shortened sail. Middle part the same. Latter part light breeze & pleasant steering to the eastward. employed mending the fore-top-sail. saw fin-backs & porpoises
