

Remarks on Board Bark Globe. 1859.

Saturday June 11th Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. with cloudy weather. heading to the westward. at 7 P.M. tacked to the S.E. & Middle & latter parts the same. employed coopersing molasses. about 120 gallons had leaked out of three cask. saw finbacks.

Sunday June 12th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. & cloudy. at 5 P.M. tacked to the W. & Middle part at 10 P.M. tacked to the S.E. latter part at 9 A.M. tacked to the westward. saw a finback.

Monday June 13th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. & cloudy. at 5 P.M. tacked to the S.E. Middle part strong breeze took in the main - topgallant - sail. latter part employed coopersing molasses. at noon tacked to the westward.

Tuesday June 14th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. & pleasant. heading to the westward. at 4 P.M. tacked to the S.E. Middle & latter parts fresh breeze at 3 A.M. tacked to the westward. saw finbacks.

Wednesday June 15th Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. & cloudy. heading to the westward. at 1 P.M. tacked to the south. wind from W.S.W. Middle part tacked to the westward. latter part moderate breeze at noon tacked to the S.E. saw finbacks.

Thursday June 16th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. & cloudy. heading S.E. Middle & latter parts employed beating to windward. tacked several times as the wind hauled. saw plenty finbacks.

Friday June 17th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. with hazy weather. heading to the westward. at 4 P.M. tacked to the S.E. Middle & latter parts strong breeze & rugged. saw finbacks.

Saturday June 18th Commences with a strong breeze from the S.W. & cloudy. heading S.E. at 8 P.M. tacked to the W. & shortened sail. Middle & latter parts light airs & calm. at 1 A.M. tacked to the eastward.

Sunday June 19th Commences with a moderate breeze from the North with foggy weather & a high swell. steering to the south. at 3 P.M. hauled to the wind to the westward. Middle part the same. latter part light airs from the NW steering to the eastward. saw finbacks.

Monday June 20th Commences with light airs from the NW with hazy weather. steering to the eastward. at 4 P.M. saw the land about 15 miles distant. bent the starboard chain. at 5 P.M. hauled to the W. & Middle & latter parts light variable winds & calm. at 4 A.M. steered in for the land. bent the larboard chain. at noon about 5 miles to the south of Little Fish Bay. saw two boats.

Tuesday June 21st Commences with light airs from the North steering in for Fish Bay. found we could not get in before dark. came to anchor in 20 fathoms water about 1 mile from the shore & about 5 miles from Fish Bay. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze & pleasant. at daylight took the anchor & stood in for Fish Bay. at 11 P.M. came to anchor in 7 fathoms water with 25 fathoms chain.

Wednesday June 22nd These 24 hours pleasant weather at daylight commenced breaking out to cooper the oil.
