Tuesday Aug 30th Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. with Cloudy weather steering N.W. & W. N.W. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same at 6 A.M. saw the Islands of St. Thomas about 20 miles distant hailed with the Keoka.

Wednesday Aug 31st Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. with Cloudy weather spoke the Rocks of St. Redford. at 3 P.M. steered N.W. the Keoka in Company. Middle & latter parts fresh breeze with some rain. at daylight saw Princess Islands. at noon off the Dutchmans Cap distant 14 miles. Chased two H. Backs. got none

Thursday Sept 1st Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. with some rain. at 1 P.M. came to anchor in Antone Bay in 7 fathoms water with 40 fathoms chain. Middle & latter parts strong breeze with some rain. at 8 A.M. the Boats went to the sea side of the Island after H. Backs

Friday Sept 2nd Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.W. with some rain. the Boats after H. Backs. the Keoka's Boats struck a whale & lost him. at 5 P.M. came on Board. Middle & latter parts strong breeze & rugged. the Boats went around the North side of the Island for H. Backs

Saturday Sept 3rd Commences with strong wind & rugged. at 4 P.M. the Boats came on Board. no H. Backs in sight to day. Middle part squally with rain. latter part more moderate. at 8 A.M. the Boats went to the South side of the Island for H. Backs

Remarks at Prince's Island 1859
Sunday Sept 4th Commences with a Moderate breeze & pleasant. saw one H. Back. at 5 P.M. the Boats came on Board. Middle & latter parts had squalls of rain. at 8 A.M. the Boats went after H. Backs the Keoka's Boats struck one & lost a line the whale went off

Monday Sept 5th Commences with squalls of rain at 5 P.M. the Boats came on Board. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. the Boats off after H. Backs. at 6 P.M. came on Board

Tuesday Sept 6th Commences with Moderate breeze with passing squalls of rain. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. at 8 P.M. the Boats went after H. Backs. a French Merchant Bark came to anchor

Wednesday Sept 7th Commences with a Moderate breeze from the Westward with passing squalls of rain saw four H. Backs going quick. at 5 P.M. the Boats came on Board. Middle part the same. latter part light breeze. at 7 A.M. took the anchor & went around the North side of the Island & came to anchor in 13 fathoms water. the Keoka in Company. Chased H. Backs

Thursday Sept 8th Commences with a Moderate breeze from the Westward. saw 5 H. Backs. Chased got none. came on Board & got out Cask for water Middle & latter parts light breeze & pleasant employed getting off water no H. Backs in sight

Friday Sept 9th Commences with pleasant weather employed getting off water & stowing it away Middle & latter parts pleasant. employed wooding
