Sunday Sept 11th Commences with light airs and pleasant. at 3 P.M. finished wooding. Middle and latter part light airs & pleasant.

Monday Sept 12th Commences with light airs & pleasant. Middle & latter parts light airs & pleasant. employed at ships Duty. no W. Backs in sight.

Tuesday Sept 13th Commences with light airs and pleasant. Middle part the same. latter part rainy waiting for gums.

Wednesday Sept 14th Commences with rainy weather. Middle & latter parts light airs & Calm. employed getting off gums.

Thursday Sept 15th Commences with light airs & Calm. Middle & latter parts light breeze from the S.W. at 10 A.M. took our anchor & stood out by the wind to the S.E. the Keoka in company.

Friday Sept 16th Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. heading by the wind to the S.E. Middle part the same. latter part light variable winds & squally with rain. employed at ships Duty. made a pair of smoke Pipes. the Keoka in company.

Saturday Sept 17th Commences with light variable winds with squalls of rain. steering by the wind heading S.E. Middle & latter parts light breeze & squally. employed working to the south. tacked several times as the wind hauled. saw two sail.

Sunday Sept 18th Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. with passing squalls. steering by the wind to the S.W. Middle & latter parts fresh breeze from the W. by S & W & squally. heading S.W. saw hump backs.

Sept 00 22.00

Monday Sept 19th Commences with a fresh breeze from the W. & S.W. with squally weather & rain. steering by the wind heading South. at 2 P.M. saw the land about 15 miles distant. a strong current running to the North. at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to the S.W. tacked to the W. & N.W. the land about 12 miles distant. Middle and latter parts passing squalls. tacked as the wind hauled. saw a sail & hump backs.

Tuesday Sept 20th Commences with a moderate breeze from the W. & S.W. with passing squalls. heading S.W. at 3 P.M. tacked to the N.W. at 5 P.M. tacked to the S.W. at 8 P.M. tacked to the N.W. Cape Lopez bore S.W. by S about 8 miles distant. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze & cloudy. tacked several times as the wind hauled.
