

Remarks on Board Bark Globe. 1860

Monday Jan 30th Commences with a moderate breeze from the North with pleasant weather steering S.W. at sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. steering S.E. saw a grampus.

Tuesday Jan 31st Commences with a moderate breeze from the N.N.W. with passing squally steering S.E. at 1 1/2 P.M. saw a school of sperm whales. lowered the Boats & got two at 9 P.M. took them to the ship. Middle part lying by the whales. latter part fresh breeze & rugged at 8 P.M. commenced cutting. at noon finished & wore ship to the N.E.

Wednesday Feb 1st Commences with a strong breeze from the South & rugged with threatening weather. steering East. employed clearing away the heads. Middle & latter parts strong breeze from the S.E. to East at 7 A.M. commenced Boiling

Thursday Feb 2^d Commences with a strong breeze from the Eastward & rugged. with Cloudy weather heading to the N.E. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same at 9 A.M. finished Boiling

Friday Feb 3^d Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.E. with passing squalls. at 1 P.M. wore ship to the South. Middle & latter parts the same saw three sail.

Saturday Feb 4th Commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. with Cloudy weather & rugged. employed stowing the between decks. saw a breach. at 5 P.M. took in the fore topsails. Middle & latter parts more moderate. wind from the S.E. to N.E. employed stowing down Oil

Sunday Feb 5th Commences with a fresh breeze from the N.E. with squally rainy weather heading to the Eastward. saw grampuses. Middle part moderate breeze & Cloudy. latter part thick hazy weather & squally. at 8 A.M. saw a school of sperm whales going quick to the North. lowered & chased them at 11 Came on Board without success.

Monday Feb 6th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. with squally weather steering E. & S. Middle part the same. latter part light variable winds & Cloudy employed stowing oil. at 10 A.M. commenced to rain. wind from S.W. to North

Tuesday Feb 7th Commences with squally rainy weather. steering E. & S. under short sail. Middle & latter parts light wind & Cloudy. steering E. & S. bound to St. Helena for a main Mast. employed at ships duty

Wednesday Feb 8th Commences with a light breeze from the W.N.W. to N.N.E. with Cloudy weather steering E. & S. to S.E. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze N.N.E. with hazy weather. steering S.E. & S. at 9 A.M. saw two sperm whales going quick to the W.N.W. lowered & got one took him to the ship

Thursday Feb 9th Commences with light airs from the N.E. with hazy weather. after dinner got ready & commenced cutting. at 6 P.M. finished & wore ship to the S.E. Middle & latter parts light breeze & pleasant. at 8 A.M. commenced Boiling
