Thursday July 12th These 24 hours light breeze. employed taking off water & stowing it away.

Friday July 13th These 24 hours pleasant weather employed stowing water sold a Boat

Saturday July 14th These 24 hours pleasant weather employed getting off water & Potatoes & Blacking the Bends

Sunday July 15th These 24 hours light wind & pleasant

Monday July 16th These 24 hours pleasant weather employed stowing away water. Painting the Bends & taking off Potatoes

Tuesday July 17th These 24 hours pleasant weather employed taking off Potatoes

Wednesday July 18th These 24 hours pleasant weather employed getting off Potatoes. took three Bullock on Board to salt

Thursday July 19th These 24 hours light air & pleasant weather employed salting Beef & getting ready for sea

Friday July 20th Commences with a Moderate breeze at 8 A.M. the Pilot came on Board we took the anchor & stood out to the N.W. the Washington of Sag Harbor in Company. saw H. Backs

Saturday July 21st Commences with a light breeze from the W. S.W. with hazy weather heading to the N.W. Middle & latter parts Moderate breeze with hazy weather heading to the W. by N. the Washington in sight. employed at ships duty

Sunday July 22nd Commences with a Moderate breeze from the S.W. with hazy weather heading to the W. by N. spoke the Washington. Middle & latter parts the same

Monday July 23rd Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. with hazy weather heading to the W. N.W. saw porpoises. Middle & latter parts the same.

Tuesday July 24th Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. with hazy weather heading to the W. N.W. Middle & latter parts light winds from S.W. to S.S.W. heading to the westward. saw finbacks

Wednesday July 25th Commences with a light breeze from the S.S.W. with cloudy weather heading to the westward. Middle & latter parts the same

Thursday July 26th Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. to W. with cloudy weather heading to the W. N.W. Middle & latter parts the same

Friday July 27th Commences with a light breeze from the S.W. with pleasant weather at 1 P.M. tacked to the S by E. at sunset took in the light sail. saw finbacks. Middle & latter parts Moderate breeze with passing squalls. at 2 A.M. tacked to the W. S.W. saw finbacks.

Song of Ch. 5.02 E.

Saturday July 28th Commences with a Moderate breeze from the South with squally weather heading to the W. S.W. at sunset double reefed the topsails. Middle & latter parts strong wind & rugged.
