

Remarks on Board Bark Globe. 1860.

Sunday July 29th Commences with a strong breeze from the South with cloudy weather and rugged. heading W. S.W. this day commenced wetting the oil. at sunset took in the mainsail, jib and spanker. Middle & latter parts strong breeze & squally steering to the westward.

Monday July 30th Commences with a strong breeze from the South with squally weather & rugged. steering to the westward. at sunset took in the main sail & fore topsail Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same.

Tuesday July 31st Commences with a strong breeze from the South with cloudy weather steering W. N.W. under short sail. saw two H. Backs. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze at daylight made sail. saw finbacks & a sail.

Wednesday August 1st Commences with a moderate breeze from the S. S.E. with cloudy weather heading to the S.W. at 5 P.M. wore ship to the Eastward & shortened sail. Middle & latter parts light air & pleasant weather. saw frampuses

Thursday Aug. 2^d Commences with light air from the W. S.W. with pleasant weather heading to the South. at sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts light breeze & pleasant weather. at 7 A.M. wore ship to the N.E. & saw finbacks

Friday Aug. 3^d Commences with a light breeze from the W. S.W. with pleasant weather heading to the N.E. & at sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts light breeze from the S.W. & heading to the S.E. saw finbacks.

Long by Ch^r 00. 31.8

Saturday Aug 4th Commences with light air from the S.W. & with pleasant weather heading to the S.E. at sunset shortened sail. Middle & latter parts strong breeze & rugged. at 7 A.M. backed to the W. S.W. saw three merchant ships steering to the N.W.

Sunday Aug. 5th Commences with a strong breeze from the South with cloudy weather & rugged. heading W. S.W. at sunset took in jib & fore topsail. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same at 7 A.M. set the fore topsail & steered N.W. saw the Washington

Long by Ch^r 00. 25.5

Monday Aug 6th Commences with a strong breeze from the S.E. with cloudy weather and rugged. steering N.E. at sunset hauled by the wind to the Eastward & took in the fore topsail. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same at 7 A.M. steered to the Westward. saw finbacks

Long by Ch^r 00. 42.5

Tuesday Aug 7th Commences with a strong breeze from the S. S.E. & squally with hazy weather steering to the westward. at sunset took in the fore topsail & hauled by the wind to the Eastward. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same at 7 A.M. steered W. N.W.
