

Remarks on Board Bar & Globe. 1860.

Wednesday Dec. 19th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. with foggy weather. Heading to the westward. at 3 P.M. tacked to the S.E. & took in sail. Middle part wore ship to the westward. Latter part moderate breeze. employed repairing the main sail

Long by Ch. 9. 31.6

Thursday Dec. 20th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. with cloudy weather. Heading to the westward. at 6 P.M. tacked to the S.E. at sunset shortened sail. saw a merchant ship steering to the N.W. Middle part at 2 A.M. tacked to the westward. Latter part wind & weather the same. saw porpoises.

Friday Dec. 21st Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. with cloudy weather. Heading to the westward. at 3 P.M. tacked to the S.E. at sunset shortened sail. Middle part the same. Latter part moderate breeze & cloudy. at 9 A.M. saw two sperm whales going south. lowered & got one

Saturday Dec. 22nd Commences with moderate breeze from the south with cloudy weather. at 2 P.M. took the whale to the ship. got ready & at 3 P.M. commenced cutting. at 7 had the body in the head along side. lost a fluke chain. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. at daylight commenced on the head. at 10 A.M. finished & stood to the S.E. & commenced boiling.

Sunday Dec. 23rd Commences with a moderate breeze from the south with cloudy weather. Heading to the S.E. employed boiling. at 11 P.M. wore ship to the S.W. Latter part at 6 A.M. tacked to the S.E.

Long by Ch. 9. 44.6

Monday Dec. 24th Commences with a moderate breeze from the south with cloudy weather. Heading to the S.E. employed boiling. Middle part at 12 wore ship to the S.W. Latter part wind & weather the same. at 8 A.M. saw a large school of sperm whales. lowered the boats & went after them. employed boiling.

Long by Ch. 9. 48.6

Tuesday Dec. 25th Commences with a moderate breeze & cloudy. The boats off after whales struck & got two. took them alongside & got ready for cutting. at 8 P.M. had the body of one in. the other one alongside. at 3 P.M. finished boiling. Middle part strong breeze & rugged. Latter part more moderate. at daylight hooked on to the head & took it in.

Wednesday Dec. 26th Commences with a moderate breeze with hazy weather. employed clearing away the head. at 2 P.M. commenced cutting. at 6 finished. Middle part at 11 A.M. commenced boiling. Heading to the S.E.

Long by Ch. 9. 39.6

Thursday Dec. 27th Commences with a fresh breeze from the south with hazy weather. Heading to the S.E. employed boiling & setting up shacks. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part at 6 P.M. tacked to the westward.

Friday Dec. 28th Commences with moderate breeze from the south. Heading to the westward. at 3 P.M. tacked to the S.E. Middle part wore ship to the S.W. Latter part moderate breeze. employed boiling & getting ready to stow oil in between decks. Middle & latter parts moderate breeze employed stowing down oil.
