

Remarks on Board Bark Globe 1861

Saturday March 2^d Commences with light baffling winds & calm with some rain. Heading to the North middle & latter parts light breeze with squally rainy weather. Heading to the N by W to N.W. saw a Merchant Bark heading to the South.

Sunday March 3^d Commences with a moderate breeze from the N.E. to N.N.E. with squally weather. Heading to the N.N.W. Middle & latter parts light airs & calm

Monday March 4th Commences with a light breeze from the S.E. to S.S.W. with pleasant weather. Steering N by W set all the standing sails. Middle & latter parts light variable winds from S.S.W. to North with cloudy weather

Tuesday March 5th Commences with a light breeze from N.N.E. to N.E. with cloudy weather. Heading N.W. to N.N.W. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same saw arabs

Wednesday March 6th Commences with light airs from the N.E. with smokey weather. Heading N.N.W. saw an English ship & Bark steering to the South. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same

Thursday March 7th Commences with light airs from the North & N.N.E. with thick smokey weather. Heading N.W. by W. Middle & latter parts light airs & calm. saw Blackfish lowered the boats & struck one the crew & we lost him. at Noon came on board

Friday March 8th Commences with light airs from the North with hazy weather. Heading W. N.W. Middle part at 12 lashed to the N.E. & S. latter part at 3 A.M. lashed to the Westward. wind light. weather thick

Saturday March 9th Commences with light airs from the North with thick hazy weather at 4 P.M. lashed to the N.E. & S. Middle & latter parts the same

Sunday March 10th Commences with light airs & calm heading to the N.N.E. at 7 P.M. had light squall from the South with rain. steered N by W. Middle & latter part moderate breeze with hazy weather. Heading to the W. & S.

Monday March 11th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. with thick hazy weather. Heading to the N.N.W. Middle part a ship passed us showing a green light. she was steering to the South. latter part wind & weather the same employed overhaling the brace blocks. saw a Double Topsail ship heading to the N.N.W.

Tuesday March 12th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. with hazy weather. Heading N.W. by N. set fore topmast standing sail. Middle & latter parts light breeze. steering N.W. by N. saw a sail

Wednesday March 13th Commences with a light breeze from the North to N.N.E. with hazy weather steering by the wind heading N.W. to N.N.W. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same. saw a sail
