Tuesday April 16<sup>th</sup> Commences with a moderate breeze from the Eastward. with passing squalls. steering W by N. Middle & latter parts wind & weather the same employed taring down the rigging.

Wednesday April 17<sup>th</sup> Commences with a moderate breeze from the E. S. E. with cloudy weather. steering W by N. saw a Bark & a Brig steering to the N. E. Middle & latter parts fresh breeze & hazy double reefed the fore topsail. saw a ship. employed clearing up the decks & off the hatchways.

Thursday April 18<sup>th</sup> Commences with a fresh breeze from the S. S. E. with hazy weather. steering west. at 6 P.M. double reefed the main topsail. Middle part squally with rain the wind shifted to the W. by W. latter part fresh breeze from the North heading to the W. by W. employed at ships Duty

Friday April 19<sup>th</sup> Commences with a light breeze from the North with a swell from the N. W. Cloudy weather. heading W. by W. Middle part the same. latter part light breeze from the S. S. E. with pleasant weather employed cooping some oil Between decks & getting ready to wash ship

Saturday April 20<sup>th</sup> Commences with a light breeze from the S. S. E. with pleasant weather. steering N. W. by N. under short sail. employed washing ship read to Paint inside. Middle part squally rainy weather with variable winds. latter part. Moderate breeze from the W. S. W. at 9 A.M. Commenced Painting ship inside saw a sail

Middle part wind & weather the same latter part moderate breeze from the E. S. E. with pleasant weather at 7 A.M. made sail steering N. W. by N. employed Painting ship on the outside. saw two sail
