

Bark Globe Bound on a whaling voyage year 1862

Saturday June 14 this day Commences with fresh breezes from the west and fair weather Course S by E under doubled reefed top sails the watch employed fitting boats middle part the same latter part fresh breezes from the S W and fair weather Course S by E at daylight set all sail so ends the day

Sunday June 15 lat 34.16 North long 64.36 West

Sunday June 15 this day Commences with fresh breezes from S W and pleasant weather Course S & all sail set saw one sail the watch employed fitting boats for whaling middle and latter part the same S & to S & all sail set saw nothing so ends the day

Monday June 16 lat 33.13 North long 62.02 West

Monday June 16 This day Commences with strong breezes from the S W and pleasant weather Course S & all sail set middle part strong breezes from S W and took in the light sails latter part light gales from S W at 5 A M doubled reefed the top sails Course S & so ends the day

Tuesday June 17 lat 33.12 North long 58.45 West

Tuesday June 17 This day Commences with fresh gales from the S W and cloudy weather Course S & saw one sail steering N E middle part strong breezes from N E with rain at 3 P M took in the jib four top sail four sail and last reefed the main ship heading to eastward latter part strong breezes from the N E and clear weather set the four sail four top sail and jib ship heading to eastward by the wind so ends the day

lat 32.55 North long 56.44 West

Remarks on Board Bark Globe year 1862

Wednesday June 18 This day Commences with strong breezes from N N E and clear weather ship heading to eastward under double reefed top sails middle part moderate latter part the same with breezes from N and pleasant weather Course S the watch employed at ships duty so ends the day

lat 32.15 North long 54.54 West

Thursday June 19 This day Commences with moderate breezes from the N and fair weather Course S the watch employed at ships duty middle and latter part moderate breezes from the S and fine weather ship heading south and Eastward by the wind at 3 A M Tacked to N N W all sail set so ends the day

lat 32.28 North long 54.19 West

Friday June 20 This day Commences with moderate breezes from the Eastward and fine weather ship heading N N W by N by the wind middle and latter part fresh breezes from the S & and fine weather ship heading S N E by the wind saw one sail so ends the day

Saturday June 21 lat 33.35 North long 53.33 West

Saturday June 21 This day Commences with fresh breezes from the S S E and fine weather ship heading N E middle and latter part moderate breezes and calms so end the day

Sunday June 22 This day Commences with Calms at 5 P M toward the boats to exercise the crew middle part the same latter part all toward for blackfish got one so ends the day

lat 34.08 North long 53.38 West

Monday June 23 This day Commences with light breezes and Calms ship heading various so ends the day

lat 33.35 North long 53.27 West
