Friday July 25th This day commences with fine weather steering by the wind with the wind from the westward at 7 P.M. gamed with the Bark Willis tacked and retacked steering by the wind middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at ship duty so ends the day

Saturday July 26th This day commences with a strong breeze from the westward tacked and retacked steering by the wind saw nothing middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at ship duty two men sick so ends the day

Sunday July 27th This day commences with pleasant weather and a moderate breeze from the North and westward heading by the wind N by E at daylight made sail wind from the N N E steering W by S middle part pleasant latter part squally and rainy employed at ship duty two men sick so ends the day

Monday July 28th This day commences with rainy weather wind from the N E steering W by S saw black fish lowered but did not get any till sail in sight at sunset double reef the topsails at daylight made all sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same watch employed at ship duty two men sick so ends the day

Tuesday July 29th This day commences with pleasant weather wind from the South and Eastward steering to the S. S. W. on sail in sight at sunset took in sail at daylight made all sail steering by the wind middle and latter part wind and weather the same the watch employed at ship duty two men sick so ends the day

Wednesday July 30th This day commences with pleasant weather with a very light breeze from the eastward steering by the wind to the N N E at sunset took in sail at daylight made all sail tacked and retacked steering by the wind middle and latter part wind and weather the same the watch employed at ship duty so ends the day

Thursday July 31th This day commences with pleasant weather tacked and retacked steering by the wind at 4 P.M. gamed with the Bark Willis sent letters home by her at sunset took in sail at daylight made all sail wind from the South and Eastward steering by the wind middle and latter part wind and weather the same the watch employed at ship duty so ends the day

Friday August 1st This day commences with fine weather steering by the wind with the wind from the Eastward at sunset shortened sail one Schooner in sight at daylight made all sail tacked and retacked steering by the wind middle and latter part wind and weather the same to men sick so ends the day

Saturday August 2nd This day commences with fine weather and light breezes from the South and Eastward steering by the wind the watch employed stowing down oil at sunset took in sail at daylight made sail steering E by S by the wind the watch employed at ship duty two men sick so ends the day

Sunday August 3rd This day commences with pleasant weather wind from the Southward steering by the wind to the S. E. at sunset took in sail at daylight made all sail steering by the wind at 8 A.M. saw black fish lowered and got one employed at ship duty two men sick so ends the day
