

Bark Globe Cruising for Sperm Whales in the year 1862

Monday August 4th This day commences with pleasant weather
Steering E by S by the wind at Sunset took in sail at
daylight made all sail the watch employed toiling
Blackfish Hucker middle and latter part wind and weather
the same one sail in sight two men sick so ends the day
Lat 36.03 N
Lon 43.48 W

Tuesday August 5th This day commences with a light breeze
from the Southward Steering by the wind to the S.E. by S
at 2 P.M. saw a breach run for it but did not see it
again at Sunset took in sail one steamer in sight
at daylight made sail Steering S.E. by E. wind from
the westward the watch employed at ships duty one
man sick so ends the day

Wednesday August 6th This day commences with pleasant weather
with a few passing squalls two sail in sight at sunset
took in sail wind from the S.S.W. steering E by S
middle and latter part wind and weather the same
the watch employed at ships duty so ends the day
Lat 35.35 N
Lon 39.29 W

Thursday August 7th This day commences with pleasant weather
wind from the S.S.W. Steering E by S two sail in sight
at sunset took in sail latter part strong breeze and
ragged weather the watch employed at ships duty
one man sick so ends the day
Lat 36.12 N
Lon 36.37 W

Friday August 8th This day commences with rugged weather
wind from the S.S.W. Steering E.S.E. under double
reef Top sails at sunset furled the fore Top sail
at daylight loosed the fore Top sail and shook the
reefs out of the main wind from the W Steering
E by N quite rugged weather the watch employed
at ships duty so ends the day
Lat 36.42 N
Lon 34.54 W

Remarks on board the Bark Globe in the year 1862

Saturday August 9th This day commences with a strong breeze
from the west Steering E by S with rugged weather latter
part more moderate Steering east the watch employed
at ships duty one man sick so ends the day
Lat 38.01 N
Lon 31.52 W

Sunday August 10th This day commences with cloudy smokey
weather wind from the W.S.W. steering E by S all sail
out bound to the Island of Nagai middle and latter
part wind and weather the same one sail in sight
the watch employed at ships duty so ends the day
Lat

Monday August 11th This day commences with moderate
smokey weather wind from the W.S.W. Steering
E by S at 8 P.M. came to anchor at the Island of
Nagai to send oil home and to discharge a sick
man at daylight commenced heaving out our
oil to send home at 1 P.M. finished and got it
ashore discharged a sick man so ends the day

Tuesday August 12th This day commences with a light breeze
from the Southward employed rafting off water and
getting of onions at 12 o'clock got the raft of water
to the ship at 4 P.M. got underway and went to sea
employed stowing chairs so ends the day

Wednesday August 13th This day commences with a strong
breeze from the Southward Steering W by N with
pleasant weather middle and latter part wind
and weather the same the watch employed at ships
duty so ends the day
Lat 39.02 N
Lon 30.02 W
