Sunday August 24th This day commences with pleasant weather wind from the Northward and Eastward steering S.E. by S. at Sunset wore ship and stood by the wind to the N.E. by N. one sail in sight middle and latter part wind and weather the same the watch employed at ships duty so ends the day

Monday August 25th This day commences with a fresh breeze from the Northward and Eastward steering by the wind to the N.W. at 1 P.M. gamed with the Brig Falcon of Salem 3 Months out. 110. Hls. at Sunset shortened sail. at daylight made sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same the watch employed at ships duty so ends the day

Tuesday August 26th This day commences with a strong breeze from the Northward and Eastward steering by the wind to the N.W. with pleasant weather at 3 P.M. raised a breach run for it but did not see it again at Sunset shortened sail and hauled on the wind again the Brig Falcon in sight at day light made sail two sail in sight wind from the Northward and Westward the watch employed at ships duty so ends the day

Wednesday August 27th This day commences with a strong breeze from the Northward and westward tacked and retacked steering by the wind with passing squalls saw nothing at sunset shortened sail two sail in sight at daylight made sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same the watch employed at ships duty so ends the day

Bemarks on board Bark Globe in the year 1862

Thursday August 28th This day commences with a moderate breeze from the westward steering by the wind at 5^{1/2} P.M. raised sperm whales lowered and chased but did not get on at dark came on board and shortened sail whales not going much at daylight made sail tacked and retacked steering by the wind wind from the westward one ship in sight at 12 midday ^{wind and weather} raised sperm whales middle and latter part the same the watch employed at ships duty so ends the day

Friday August 29th This day commences with pleasant weather wind from the westward at 1 P.M. toward and struck at sunset got him alongside and fluked took in sail heading by the wind to the Southward at daylight commenced cutting at 9 A.M. finished middle part pleasant latter rainy so ends the day

Saturday August 30th This day commences with rainy weather and a moderate breeze from the westward ship heading N. by W. two sail in sight employed cutting up junk and clearing away the head at 6 A.M. commenced hauling middle part squally latter part pleasant so ends the day

Sunday August 31st This day commences with pleasant weather light wind from the Northward and Westward ship heading by the wind to the N.E. by E. employed hauling one sail in sight at 9^{1/2} finished hauling at 12 midday passed Longitudinal with an English Bark steering to the Northward so ends the day
