Tuesday Sept 7th This day commenced with a gale from the Southward heading by the wind to the E.S.E. heavy sea on under clew reef main top sail and fore sail & fourth mast stay set one sail in sight at daylight made sail weather more moderate employed at Ship duty

Wednesday Sept 10th This day commenced with pleasant weather and from the Northward and Westward steering by the wind to the S.E. by E. at sunset shortened sail latter part blowing strong from the S.W. steering S.E. by E. under double reef top sails employed at Ship duty

Thursday Sept 11th This day commenced with squally rain weather steering S.E. by E. under double reef top sails at daylight made sail steering by the wind to the E.N.E. wind from the Southward and Eastward employed at Ship duty
