Monday Sept 19th This day commenced with pleasant weather
wind from the Northward and retarded steering
by the wind at sunset shortened sail at daylight made
all sail steering S.E. wind from the Westward at 8 AM
raised a sperm whale at 9 AM lower at 10 AM struck
at the 11 AM got him alongside and fluked at 1 PM
commenced cutting at daylight the head off and

Tuesday Sept 20th This day commenced with squally rain
weather wind from the Northward and Eastward head
alongside one sail in light ship heading to the Westward
quite rugged at 7 AM commenced cutting the head
at 10 AM finished at the 11 AM commenced sailing wind
from the Northward and Eastward steering S.W. rugged
Legt 400 33 22 1/2

Wednesday Sept 21st This day commenced with pleasant weather
but rugged wind from the Northward and Eastward
steering S.W. under double main top sail and
forward employed boiling at 10 o'clock hauled by the wind
to the N.E. wind from the N.W. rugged and squally

Can 400 29 43 1/2

Thursday Sept 22nd This day commenced with squally weather
heavy up on ship heading by the wind to the N.E. wind
from the Northward and Westward employed
boiling at daylight finished boiling wind from the
Northward and Westward steering S.W. blowing a moderate
gale

Remarks on Board Back Globe the year 1862

Friday Sept 23rd This day commenced with a gale of wind
from the Northward and Westward steering S.W. under
close reef main top sail two storm topsails and foretop
mast stayed at sunset hauled by the wind to the S.W.
gale a little more moderate heavy sea running at day-
light more moderate made some sail gale both up
employed cooking oil No oil

Saturday Sept 24th This day commenced with pleasant weather
wind from the Northward steering by the wind to the N.E.
at daylight made all sail employed steering down oil
middle and latter part wind gale weather the same
Legt 400 33 00 1/2
Can 400 29 13 1/2

Sunday Sept 25th This day commenced with a moderate breeze
Northward steering by the wind to the N.E. at 5 PM raised
sperm whale at 6 PM lower and chased came on deck
and came on board whale walking to the Westward shortened
sail at daylight made all sail employed at Ship Day
Legt 400 32 12 1/2
Can 400 29 21 1/2

Monday Sept 26th This day commenced with squally weather
tactia and retarded steering by the wind at sunset shortened
sail at daylight made all sail steering from the
Northward tactia and retarded steering by the wind middle
and latter part wind and weather the same employed
at Ship Day

Tuesday Sept 27th This day commenced with pleasant weather
steering by the wind to the N.E. wind from the Northward
at sunset shortened sail at daylight made full steering
by the wind to the N.E. middle and latter part wind and
weather the same employed at Ship Day
