

Bark Globe cruising for sperm the year 1862

Monday Dec 8th This day commenced with pleasant weather steering by the wind to the W by N at 6 PM spoke the Bark *Keatowassell* of Westport 2 months out for the sperm tacked and detached steering by the wind some from the Southward and Westward employed at Ship Deck one man sick

Long 135° 2'

Tuesday Dec 9th This day commenced with pleasant weather heavy swell on steering by the wind to the Westward in sight tacked and detached steering by the wind some from the Westward the Bark in sight Middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at Ship Deck one man sick

Lat 40° 40' S
Long 136° 20'

Wednesday Dec 10th This day commenced with a moderate breeze from the forward steering by the wind at 4 PM spoke the Bark *Union* of New Bedford and Bark *Mercury* of Eastport at sunset shortened sail heavy swell on latter part blowing strong from the Eastward when double reef was made one man sick

Thursday Dec 11th This day commenced with cloudy weather blowing strong from the Eastward steering by the wind to the N by E the sail in sight tacked and detached steering by the wind some from the Northward and Eastward blowing strong employed at Ship Deck one man sick

Remarks on Board Bark Globe the year 1862

Friday Dec 12th This day commenced with rainy weather blowing strong from the Northward and Eastward steering by the wind to the E by S under double reef tacked at 3 PM spoke the Brig *Kap-Coy* of Westport 2 months out at sunset parted the foretopmast blowing strong employed at Ship Deck at day light blowing a gale from the Northward under reef close reef main topmast and reef foretopmast tacked one man sick

Lat 40° " S
Long 136° " W

Saturday Dec 13th This day commenced with a light breeze moderate weather heavy swell on steering by the wind smalls carried away the Bar had Day come away from lowering the Bar some hauled to the foremast steering N by E at day light made sail steering N by E wind from the Southward employed at Ship Deck one man sick

Long 136° " W

Sunday Dec 14th This day commenced with strong breeze from the Southward steering N by E at sunset double reefed the topsail cloudy weather at day light made sail some from the Southward steering E by N weather strong breeze employed at Ship Deck one sail in sight one man sick

Monday Dec 15th This day commenced with a strong breeze from the Southward with fine and weather steering E by N at 3 PM hauled to the foremast at sunset double reefed the topsail Middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at Ship Deck quite rugged
