Thursday March 20th This day commences with fine weather strong trade from the SE at 11 o'clock ahead of the harbor of St. Helena Capt. sent ashore to the last laying off and on at sunset stood out of the line to the ENE one man sick

Friday March 21st This day commences with pleasant weather at 8 o'clock the boat ashore laying off and on at the Island of St. Helena fresh breeze from the SE discharged a sick man and one man run away at sunset the boat came aboard the Capt. ashore stood out in the line to the ENE the discharged man named Charles Downing

Monday March 24th This day commences with fine weather laying off and on at the Island of St. Helena at 8 o'clock the boat ashore at sunset the boat came aboard the Capt. ashore stood out in the line to the ENE from the SE fresh

Tuesday March 25th This day commences with pleasant weather at 8 o'clock the Capt. came aboard did not get the morning his name was John C. Good stood out of the line to the SE fresh trade from the SE Middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at ship Day at sunset shortened sail

Wednesday March 26th This day commences with pleasant weather strong breeze from the SE tacked and retacked steering by the line in whaler in sight Middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at ship Day the Island in sight at sunset shortened sail

Thursday March 27th This day commences with fine weather the SE at daylight made sail tacked and retacked steering by the line in whaler in sight Middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at ship Day at sunset shortened sail
