and latter part wind and weather the same employed
Bulling Redfish the sail in sight 10 at 4.25. 11

Friday May 15th This day commenced with pleasant weather fresh
breeze from the N.E. steering N.W. Middle and latter
part wind and weather the same employed at
Ship Duf one sail in sight Leg of 25. 15. 11
Lea of 45. 33. 11

Saturday May 16th This day commenced with fine weather fresh
breeze from the N.E. steering N.W. Middle and
latter part wind and weather the same employed
at Ship Duf Leg of 27. 15. 11
Lea of 44. 24. 11

Sunday May 17th This day commenced with fine weather
fresh breeze from the Eastward steering N.W. Middle at
daylight made sail latter part steering N.W. altered
shortened sail employed at Ship Duf Leg of 28. 20. 11
Lea of 49. 25. 11

Monday May 18th This day commenced with fine
weather wind fresh from the Eastward steering
N.W. latter part steering West saw four black emp-
loyed mending sails at dinner shortened sail
and hauled by the line to the South Leg of 28. 17. 11

latter part and latter part from the Southward and
Eastward at 5 A.M. raised a school of sperm whales
bored and got them one he got alongside at midday was
at 12 o'clock at night shortened sail Leg of 28. 19. 11

finished cutting latter part employed cutting up sperm
