Saturday May 23rd This day commences with pleasant weather fresh breeze from the Northward & Westward employed Ballin Tackle and detached steering of the wind at 11 AM finished Ballin on sail in sight at sunset shortened sail Log of day 28. 30. N
Son of day 52. 54. 2

Sunday May 24th This day commences with pleasant weather strong breeze from the Northward & Westward under four masts Toppers Middle part steering ENE latter part steering ENE at sunset pulled the foretop sails and hauled of the wind to the S. E. employed at ship duty Log of day 28. 22. N
Son of day 52. 02. 2

Monday May 25th This day commences with rain weather looked light from the Westward began to blow from employed stowing down Oil latter part stowed down Oil steering of the wind to the S. E. at sunset shortened sail Log of day 28. 16. N
Son of day 52. 09. 2

Tuesday May 26th This day commences with pleasant weather fresh breeze from the Westward & North and detached steering of the wind at daylight made sail Middle and latter part wind weather the same employed at ship duty at sunset shortened sail heading of the wind to the S. E. Log of day 28. 16. N

Wednesday May 27th This day commences with cloudy weather fresh breeze from the Westward Middle part steering N. E. latter part steering S. E. at sunset shortened sail and hauled of the wind to the S. E. employed at ship duty saw fairwinds Log of day 28. 30. N
Son of day 52. 54. 2

Thursday May 28th This day commences with fine weather fresh breeze from the Northward and Westward Tackles and detached steering of the wind Middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at ship duty at sunset shortened sail heading of the wind to the S. E. Log of day 28. 22. N
Son of day 52. 02. 2

Friday May 29th This day commences with fine weather fresh breeze from the Northward Tackles and detached steering of the wind Middle and latter part wind & weather the same at sunset shortened sail heading of the wind to the S. E. in sight Log of day 28. 30. N
Son of day 52. 09. 2

Saturday May 30th This day commences with fine weather fresh breeze from the Northward and Eastward Tackles and detached steering of the wind at 10 AM spoke the schooner. Russell King of Fair Haven Middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed at ship duty at sunset shortened sail heading of the wind to the Northward & Westward one sail in sight Log of day 28. 30. N
