schooner Rosewell King of New Haven at sunset shortened sail
steering by the wind to the S.W. Lat of 31.20. N
Long 48.52. W

Thursday June 12th This day commences with pleasant weather
Moderate breeze from the Westward steering by the wind
to the N.W. Middle and latter part wind and weather the
same and what in sight at sunset shortened sail employed
ship day Lat of 31.10. N
Long 48.51. W

Friday June 13th This day commences with fine weather light
breeze from the Northward at 10 A.M. having sperm whale
board and chased no wind did not get on at last
came on board shortened sail heading by the wind to the
S.W. Lat of 32.56. N
Long 48.51. W

steering E.N.E. at sunset shortened sail now ship and
hauling by the wind to the Westward Middle and latter
part wind and weather the same at sunset shortened
sail heading by the wind to the S.W. employed at ship day
Lat of 31.59. N
Long 48.52. W

Sunday June 15th This day commences with fine weather fresh
breeze from the Westward tacking and tacking steering
by the wind Middle and latter part wind and weather
the same three sails in sight at sunset shortened sail
heading by the wind to the S.W. Lat of 31.58. N
Long 48.51. W

Monday June 16th This day commences with fine weather fresh
breeze from the Northward and Eastward tacking and
tacking steering by the wind to the Westward and Eastward
Middle and latter part wind and weather the same
employed at ship day at sunset shortened sail
heading by the wind to the S.W. Lat of 31.57. N
Long 48.51. W

Tuesday June 17th This day commences with mostly happy
weather fresh breeze from the Westward Middle
part steering East latter part steering E.N.E. at sunset
shortened sail and hauling by the wind to the S.W.
