 and one Dutch boards an american ship I hope from Boston
 got some lat paper Middle and latter part fine and
 weather the same at sunset shortened sail heading by the
 sun to the N. of W. Lat 35. 5. N
 Long 67. 3. W

Tuesday July 14th This day commences with fine weather moderate
 breeze from the Westward steering by the wind to the N. E.
 Middle and latter part fine and weather the same at
 sunset shortened sail employed at ship duty Lat 35. 12. N
 Long 67. 35. W

Wednesday July 15th This day commences with fine weather and moderate
 breeze from the Northward and Eastward North and Westward
 steering by the wind saw a steamer steering S. W. Southward
 and Westward at sunset shortened sail heading by the sun
 to the N. of W. Middle and latter part fine and weather the same
 employed at ship duty Lat 35. 2. N
 Long 67. 2. W
