Sunday Sept 6th This day commences with pleasant weather light breeze from the Northward & Eastward tack and detected steering of the wind the Island in sight 40 miles Middle part very light air light fast moderate breeze heading with wind to the S.E. passed San with a spruce bark loaded with sugar bound to Baltimore & England no man sick

Monday Sept 7th This day commences with pleasant weather wind very light tack and detected steering of the wind trying to beat up both Islands same fast & moderate 20 miles was a calm space the bark received 1 month out 400 lbs sperm one man sick
