

Ball's Globe cruising for sperm the year 1860

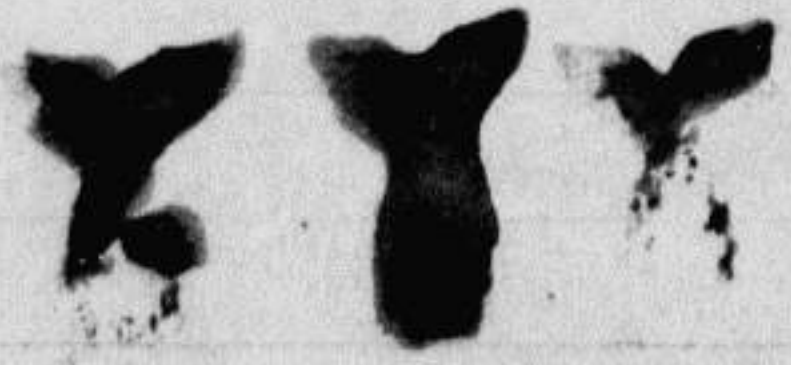
Saturday Dec 19th This day commences with pleasant weather

Northward tacked at 11 AM by the wind to the W. heavy sea on
Middle and latter part wind and weather the same
employed at ship's duty one man off duty

Monday Dec 21st This day commences with a gale from the
Northward heavy sea on latter part wind moderate by
the wind to the Eastward employed at ship's duty one man
off duty

Tuesday Dec 22nd This day commences with a strong gale from
the Northward heavy sea on middle and latter part wind
clear up somewhat heading by the wind to the Eastward
Middle and latter part wind and weather the same
employed at ship's duty one man off duty
Lat Feb 35. 12. S
Long Feb 26. 10. W

Wednesday Dec 23rd This day commences with a gale from the
Northward tacked and tacked heading by the wind
at 10 AM wind bright whale so rugged did not leave for
them heavy sea on Middle and latter part wind and
weather the same employed at ship's duty
Lat Feb 35. 31. S
Long Feb 27. 36. W



Remarks on Board Ball's Globe the year 1860

Thursday Dec 24th This day commences with a moderate
breeze from the Northward steering by the wind at 11
AM rain bright whale landed and chased at 3 PM came
on board at 5 PM landed again and got on at 10 PM night
got him alongside and flukes on board got stone
Lat Feb 36. 34

Friday Dec 25th This day commences with pleasant weather very light
air from the northeast at 11 AM commences cutting
at 1 PM finished at 4 PM commences cutting ship
heading by the wind to the Middle and latter part wind
and weather the same employed at ship's duty
Lat Feb 36. 57. S
Long Feb 27. 00. W



Saturday Dec 26th This day commences with fine weather
wind light from the Northward at 11 AM land for
right whale at 11 AM struck and killed him he was
about five fathoms and three hundred thirty
fathoms of line employed cutting Middle and latter
part wind and weather the same employed at ship's duty
heading by the wind to the Middle and latter part
wind and weather the same employed at ship's duty
Lat Feb 36. 28. S
Long Feb 27. 28. W



Sunday Dec 27th This day commences with strong weather moderate
breeze from the northeast tacked and tacked steering by the
wind latter part strong and squally sea employed at
ship's duty

at 10 PM first dated finished cutting at 10 PM he com-
menced slowing down at sunset finished some
light from the Northward and Eastward tacked
and tacked steering by the wind
