Sunday Apr 22nd This day commences with fine weather. Steaming from the Northward and Eastward under short sail steering of the line to the Northward at 2 PM saw ship and stood of the line to the Southward and Eastward. Log of 12.11
Com John 38.19.6

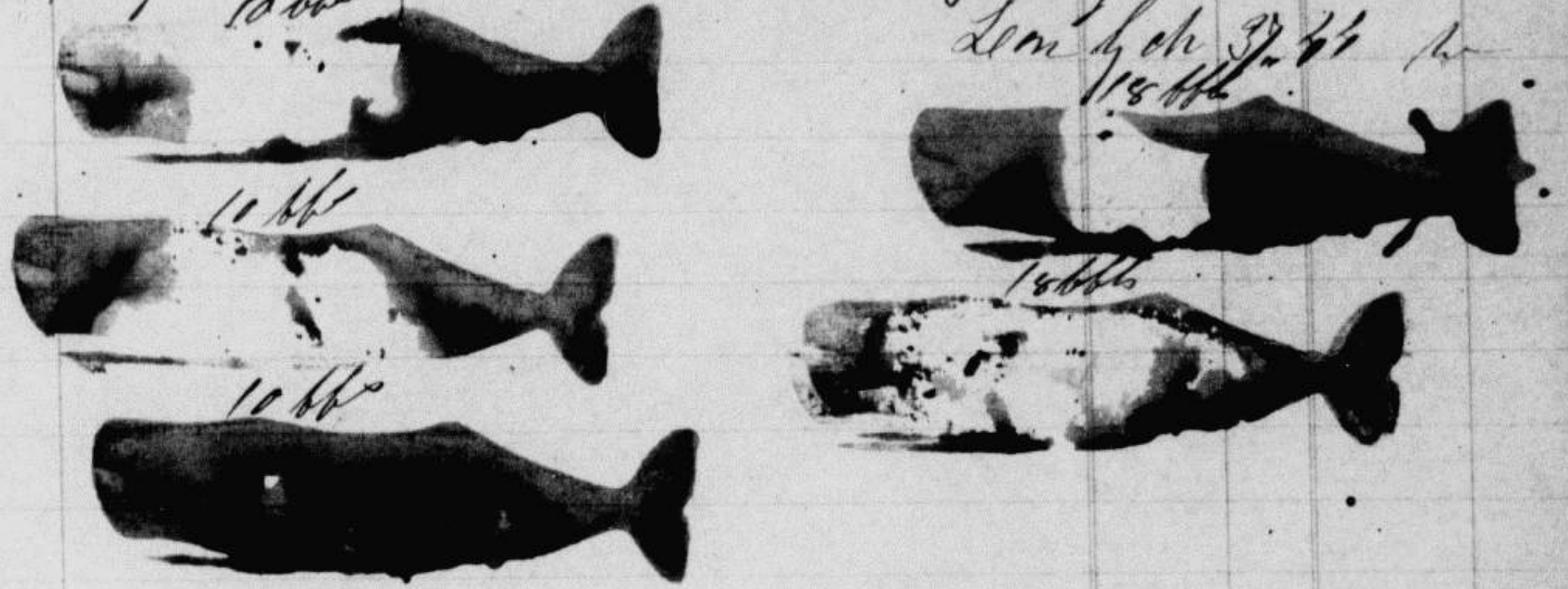
Saturday Apr 23rd This day commences with pleasant weather strong breeze from the Northward and Eastward steering of the line to the Northward latter part more moderate at 1 PM saw ship and stood of the line to the Southward and Eastward employed at ship duty. Log of 14.18.11

Sunday Apr 24th This day commences with fine weather strong breeze from the Northward and Eastward steering of the line at sunset shortened sail Middle and latter part fine and weather the same employed at ship duty. Log of 13.58.11

Monday Apr 25th This day commences with fine weather Moderate breeze from the Northward & Eastward steering of the line employed repairing cable at sunset shortened sail steering of the line to the Southward and Eastward Middle and latter part fine and weather the same employed at ship duty. Log of 14.13.11

Remarks on Board Barth Globe the year 1864

Tuesday Apr 26th This day commences with fine weather Steaming to the line to the Northward and Eastward at daylight raised a school of sperm whale at 8 AM struck and got fine at 1 PM got them alongside at 2 PM commences cutting at last finished employed clearing away one sail in night ship heaving to the Northward. Log of 14.10.11

Wednesday Apr 27th This day commences with fine weather at 8 AM saw ship and stood of the line to the Southward and Eastward employed cutting up junk at 8 AM commences balling one sail in night Middle and latter part fine and weather the same. Log of 14.08.11

Thursday Apr 28th This day commences with fine weather steering of the line to the Southward Moderate breeze from the Northward & Eastward at 1 PM saw ship and stood of the line to the Northward Middle and latter part fine and weather the same employed balling. Log of 13.10.11
