N

Saturday Apr. 30th This day commences with fine weather to the North and Eastward steering of the ship employed sailing down oil at 4 PM finished Middle and latter part fine and weather the same at sunset shortened sail steering of the ship to the Northward and Eastward Log fol 12. 50. N

Sunday May 1st This day commences with pleasant weather to the North and Eastward steering of the ship moderate breeze from the Northward and Eastward at 5 PM saw Black fish land and got no bird sail in sight at sunset shortened sail ship heading of the ship to the Northward Middle and latter part fine and weather the same Log fol 12. 57. N

Monday May 2nd This day commences with fine weather to the North and Eastward steering of the ship employed sailing Black fish Moderate breeze from the Eastward no sail in sight at sunset shortened sail heading of the ship to the Northward and Eastward Log fol 13. 58. N

Tuesday May 3rd This day commences with fine weather moderate breeze from the Northward and Eastward to the North and Eastward steering of the ship at 6 AM received sperm whales at the house at the street at 12 noon got him along side and flaked 2 PM captured 1000 lbs of sperm finished sailing heading of the ship to the Northward Log fol 13. 50

Wednesday May 4th This day commences with fine weather to the North and Eastward steering of the ship at 6 AM commenced sailing fresh breeze from the Northward and Eastward at sunset shortened sail heading of the ship to the Southward and Eastward Middle and latter part fine and weather the same employed sailing Log fol 13. 54. N

Thursday May 5th This day commences with fine weather fresh breeze from the Southward and Eastward to the North and Eastward steering of the ship at 6 PM finished sailing at sunset shortened sail steering of the ship to the Northward Log fol 13. 58. N
