last part fine and light the same arrival  
day we amuse our ship Capt J. S. " "

Tuesday June 16<sup>th</sup> This day commences with rainy  
weather employed beating out oil from  
at the Island of Royal Middle gate last part  
wind and weather the same Capt J. S. " "

Wednesday June 17<sup>th</sup> This day commences with rainy weather  
lying at anchor at the Island of Royal discharging  
oil at 11 AM the last part cold wind with squally  
pleasant to whale legs of and on the ship James  
Murray and Capt J. S. of New Bedford  
Capt J. S. " "

Thursday June 18<sup>th</sup> This day commences with cloudy  
weather lying at anchor at the Island of Royal  
employed get ballast from shore full of pleasure  
from water getting ballast Capt J. S. " "

Friday June 19<sup>th</sup> This day commences with fine weather  
lying at anchor at the Island of Royal arrival to day  
the whaler Bark Isaac of New Bedford employed  
at ship Dept Capt J. S. " "

Saturday June 20<sup>th</sup> This day commences with pleasant  
weather lying at anchor at the Island of Royal  
sails to day we whaler schooner employed  
at ship Dept Capt J. S. " "

Tuesday June 21<sup>st</sup> This day commences with pleasant  
weather lying at anchor at the Island of Royal  
employed getting off barrels fresh beef from the  
Capt J. S. " "

Wednesday June 22<sup>nd</sup> This day commences with fine  
weather lying at anchor at the Island of Royal  
fresh beef from the Southman and Capt J. S.  
allied for sea ships to day afternoon day and  
discovered a Catque Boat containing some Indian  
Capt J. S. " "

Thursday June 23<sup>rd</sup> This day commences with fine  
weather lying at anchor at the Island of Royal one  
man employed to day name George Leclair for  
small barrel fresh beef from the ship for sea  
Capt J. S. " "

Friday June 24<sup>th</sup> This day commences with pleasant  
weather lying at anchor at the Island of Royal ships to day  
a forenoon and at 1 PM beg this anchor and sail  
from the Island of Royal in company with the  
Bark Isaac Steer N.W. fresh beef from the Eastman  
Capt J. S. " "

Saturday June 25<sup>th</sup> This day commences with cloudy  
smoky weather at 2 PM sighted the Island of Cape  
and Cape to sails in light steam N.W. at 11 AM  
the Meddane last part fine and weather the  
same sail for boat Capt J. S. 29.30 " "

Sunday June 26<sup>th</sup> This day commences with pleasant  
weather lying off and on at the Island of Cape  
getting ready all aboard at anchor the Bark Isaac  
Murray the capt whaler Steer N.W. by the line to the  
N.E. the date from the Eastman  
Capt J. S. " "
