 to the area both with the wind and sails
 part time and weather the same. Employed
 setting up rigging at some distance. Sail
 Log of day 34.14 N

Thursday July 28th This day commenced with fine
 weather. Made out from the detached
 steam light line both Southward late part
 steam. The line both the fore and aft
 employed cutting down the sails in sight
 Log of day 33.00
 Ton foh 35.12.

Friday July 29th This day commenced with cloudy weather
 fresh breeze from the southward and pleasant
 steering. The line both the fore and aft
 on wind and late part time and weather
 the same. Log of day 33.17 N
 Ton foh 36.00 N

Saturday July 30th This day commenced with pleasant
 weather fresh breeze from the northeast steering
 to the area both with the wind and sails in sight
 wind and late part time and weather the same
 Log of day 34.04
 Ton foh 36.09

Sunday July 31st This day commenced with fine
 weather steering to the line both the fore and
 aft and late part time and weather the same
 at some distance. The whaling
 schooner Valantine Dean of Provincetown 5 months

 Monday August 1st This day commenced with fine weather
 moderate breeze from the northeast steering
 to the area both with the wind and sails in sight
 part time and weather the same. Employed
 sail on light at some distance sail ship heading
 to the Southward and Eastward
 Log of day 35.08 N
 Ton foh 38.44 N

Tuesday August 2nd This day commenced with pleasant
 weather light breeze from the northeast steering
 to the area both Southward late part calving employed
 ship. at mid. Log of day 34.53
 Ton foh 38.11

Wednesday August 3rd This day commenced with fine weather
 calm air light air from the northeast employed
 at ship sail. Wind and late part time and
 weather the same. Log of day 35.18 N
 Ton foh 38.34 N

Thursday August 4th This day commenced with
 pleasant weather calm head of all parts of the
 compass at 1 PM used a school of sperm whales
 line and got an catch at daylight and
 employed. Wind and late part time and
 weather the same. Log of day 36.20 N



Friday August 5th This day commenced with pleasant
 calm day light commenced cutting at 2 PM
 employed employed cutting up small part of
 light breeze from the southward and Eastward
 steering West. Wind and late part time and
 weather the same. Log of day 36.38 N
