Remarks Tuesday July 25th 29th Day.
First part light air. Later calms. repaired
the foremast top sail. Middle and latter squally
from the southward. Course S.W.

Lat 33-42 Long 45-31

Remarks Wednesday July 26th 30th Day.
First part moderate breeze from S.W. course N.W. by E.
Latter part moderate breeze.

Lat 34-54 Long 44-22

Remarks Thursday July 27th 31st Day.
First part moderate breeze from S.W. course
N.W. by E. Latter part pleasant breeze from S.E.
I am here sick.

Lat 36-41 Long 42-52

Remarks Friday July 27th 32nd Day.
First part moderate breeze from S.E. heading
by to the N.E. my dear friends I wish I was with
you to night. Latter part moderate breeze
from N.E. heading to the Northward. Saw 33 fish get on.

Lat 37-58 Long 42-56

Remarks Saturday July 30th 33rd Day.
First part light air from S.E. steering
N.W. by E. Latter part moderate.

Lat 39-10 Long 42-13

Remarks Sunday July 30th 34th Day.
First part light air from the South.
Course N.W. by E. Latter part moderate. Steering
by to the Eastward. two birds in sight heading
the same. I should like
to be at home to night.

Lat 40-32 Long 40-45

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Remarks Monday July 31st 1865. 35th Day.

First part light breeze from S.E. and a heavy
swell. heading by to the Eastward.
Latter part strong winds from S.E. Double reefed
top in fore and main sail. heading to the Eastward.

Lat 41-45 Long 39-01

Remarks Tuesday Aug 1st 36th Day.
First part strong breeze from S.E. heading by to
exchange signals with an English brig.
Latter part moderate. at 2 A.M. were ship to the
S.W.

Lat 42-04 Long 38-41

Remarks On Wednesday Aug 2nd 37th Day.
First part moderate breeze from S.E. heading
S.W. Latter part strong winds. under double reef. main
sail and foremast.

Lat 40-29 Long 36-00

Remarks Thursday Aug 3rd 38th Day.
First part strong winds from S.E. and squally. under
double reef. Latter part fresh breeze and rain.
at 2 A.M. were ship to the Eastward. No obs.

Remarks Friday Aug 4th 39th Day.
First part wind S.E. by S and rain. heading
to the Eastward. Latter part moderate breeze
from S.W. Course S.E.

Lat 40-21 Long 36-54

Remarks Saturday Aug 5th 40th Day.
First part moderate breeze from S.W. steering
S.E. Latter part moderate breeze from E. heading S.E.
Saw 40 birds and grampuss. Saw seven the Royal gulls
and put up traps.

Lat 41-23 Long 36-02

Remarks Sunday Aug 6th 41st Day.
First part light breeze from N.E. heading S.E.
Latter part moderate from the Eastward with foggy
squalls.
