Remarks Wednesday Oct 4th 1865. 100th
First part moderate breeze from East. Steering
S. Employed starting water and cooping & bulad
and blower. two sails in sight. Latter part squally.
at 6 1/2 P.M. raised a school of sperm whales going
to the westward. at 8 towards the boats the
boats & boat hook one missed with a fair chance
chase on the whales going to the seaward.

Lat 28-40 Long 22-10
Remarks On Thursday Oct 5th. 101st
First part moderate breeze from the S.E.
& boats chasing whales. at 2 P.M. the boats
gave up the chase. Latter part light airs.

Lat 2-50
Remarks Friday Oct 6th. 102nd Day.
First part light breeze from East. course
by N. at 5 P.M. finished cooping provisions
board. Starting the water. Pumped and filled
with salt water about 135 bbls of the ground
in the main hatch. two sails in sight
ahead. Latter part light airs.

Lat 6-33 Long 22-14
Remarks Saturday Oct 7th 103rd Day.
First part light airs and calms.
Latter part light airs and baffling. with
squalls of rain. no Ob

Remarks Sunday Oct 8th. 104th Day.
First part light and baffling from N.E.
to W and rain. Middle part fresh breeze and
squally from S.W. Latter part moderate and
baffling with heavy rain. Another Sunday is
past. I have been thinking of home all day. How
we used to pass our rainy Sundays. O dear
how are my friends thinking of home. do they
think of me as often as I do of them. I wonder
I know so. if they do they will not forget me.

heading to the southward. Lat 2-51 Long 20-45

Remarks Tuesday Oct 10th. 106th Day.
First part light airs from the W.S.W.
heading to the southward. Middle part squally.
Latter part light airs and baffling. with rain.

Remarks Wednesday Oct 11th 107
First part light airs from S.W. heading to the
S.E. One sail in sight. Latter part took a
breeze from the South. heading N.W. saw
two sails. Lat 3-22 Long 20-34

Remarks Thursday Oct 12th. 108th
First part fresh breeze from the South
heading N.W. Latter part moderate breeze.
One sail in sight. Lat 4-57 Long 22-51

Remarks Friday Oct 13th. 109th
First part moderate breeze from the South
heading N.W. repaired the spanker. Latter
part moderate. Employed repairing the main sail.

Lat 10-47 Long 24-10
Remarks Saturday Oct 14th. 110th Day.
First part moderate breeze from South
heading N.W. went the main top mast
stay & sail. Latter part moderate. Crossed the
Line. Lat 00-25 S. Long 26-43
