First part moderate breezes from S by W.
heading W by S. Saw three Sails. Latter part
light breezes. and fine. Lat 2-07 S. Long 28-20

Remarks Monday Oct 16th 119th Day.
First part light breezes from S by E heading
S by W. Middle and latter parts fresh breezes
from S E. Steering by to the NW. Lat 4-29 Long 30-44

Remarks Tuesday Oct 17th 120th Day.
First part fresh trades from S E by S heading
by to the S W. two sails in sight that we
have come up with. we have passed every thing
we have seen on the passage going as we are.
Middle and latter parts strong trades took in
top. Sails and masts. Exchanged signals
with a Swedish Brig Lat 7-30 Long 30-59

Remarks Wednesday Oct 18th 121st Day.
First part strong trades from S E heading S W.
the Brig is sight. Latter part strong trades.
Steering by to the S W under top sails. Lat 10-08 Long 31-44

Remarks Thursday Oct 19th 122nd Day.
First part strong trades from S E by E
steering by to the S W under top sails.
Latter part strong trades. Saw Bird Backs. Lat 13-10 Long 32-11

Remarks Friday Oct 20th 123rd Day.
First part strong trades from S E heading
S W. Saw a Brig. Latter strong trades. Under
top sails. Lat 15-50 Long 32-45

Remarks Saturday Oct 21st 124th Day.
Strong trades from S E. Steering by to the S W
under top sails. Latter part strong winds. Under
top sails. repaired the top. Lat 18-26 Long 33-46

Remarks Sunday Oct 22nd 125th Day.
First part strong breezes from S E heading
by to the S W under top sails. Latter part squally. heading. another lamesame
Sunday is past and gone. I have thought of home
all day. I wonder if you have got my letters
yet. what have you been doing today. have you
been to church. I should like to be with you
to night. O dear me what a life. Lat 20-45 Long 33-33

Remarks Monday Oct 23rd 126th Day.
First part strong winds from the Eastward
and squally. heading by to the South. Double
reefed top sails. Latter fresh breezes. at 7 A.M.
raised a school of small whales. at 8 saw one. Struck
three. parted from one got two. the loose whales
bit off the line. at 11 got one to the ship. Lat 22-08 Long 33-11

Remarks Tuesday Oct 24th 127th Day.
First part moderate at 1 P.M. took the other
whale to the ship. at 2 commenced cutting. at 5
finished Latter part fresh breezes from N E by
N. Course S E. at 7 P.M. commenced dailing. Lat 23-29 Long 33-20

Remarks Wednesday Oct 25th 128th Day.
First part moderate breezes from N E
Course S E changed the course so that we could
dail. Passed the French Ship. Passing of
Havre. Latter part moderate. at 5 P.M.
finished dailing the whale turned up. 11 P.M.
Saw a steamer steering to the Northward.
How are my friends to night. well I hope
I wish I could see them. Lat 24-34 Long 34-26
