Remarks Sunday Oct 29th 125th
First part moderate breezes from the
Eastward. Course S. Latter part moderate.
I have thought much of home to day. and wished
many times that I could be there with my friends.
I have thought of Leo and wondered if she
meant to go out to work. There is every thing to keep
me in suspense. Lat 31-12 Long 29-17

Remarks Monday Oct 30th 126th
First part moderate breezes from E.N.E. Course
S. Latter part moderate. Lat 33-01

Remarks Tuesday Oct 31st 127th
First light breezes from N.E. Course S.E.
Latter part moderate breezes. Steering S.E. by E
two merchantmen in sight. At 11 P.M. raised
a school of sperm whales, going to N.N.W. a large
body of them, large and small. Lat 34-22 Long 27-00

First part moderate breezes from N.N.E. at
12 P.M. lowered the boats. at struck two.
at 6 P.M. took one to the ship, at 7 took the other
along side. Set the watch and prepared for

cutting. Lat 35-01 Long 27-22

Remarks Thursday Nov 2nd 129th Day.
First part moderate breezes from N.W. by
N. Employed cutting. at 5 P.M. finished.
prepared for dailing. Latter part fine
weather. Employed dailing. Lat 34-56 Long 26-48

Remarks Friday Nov 3rd 130th Day.
First part moderate breezes from N.W. by E.
Employed dailing. Oh dear the loss I have one
of your can. forter. and an awful one too.
it makes me sick at over. I cannot eat or any
thing else with any comfort. Latter part strong
winds. took in the fore and main top sails. I have
of your cakes for supper too night. It was real
nice. Lat 34-42 Long 28-24

Remarks Saturday Nov 4th 131st Day.
First part fresh gale from the North and thick
weather. dailing under ease. reef main top
sail and fore sail. Latter part strong
winds and raining. at 7 P.M. finished dailing the
whales. turned boats. Lat 36-00

Remarks Sunday Nov 5th 132nd Day.
First part moderate breezes from S.W.
and raining. Latter part fresh breezes and cloudy
from S.E. with a heavy surge from the S.W.
another school is past. I have often thought
of home to day. It is cold and disagreeable
here. Lat 35-07
